WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

St. Louis County residents 16-24 years of age who are **currently not attending any school**

Must meet one or more of the following:

- ✓ School Dropout
- ✓ Should be in school but did not attend the last calendar quarter (Compulsory Attendance)
- ✓ Low income, high school graduate who is basic skills deficient or an English language learner
- ✓ Subject to the juvenile or adult justice system
- ✓ Homeless, runaway, foster child or aged out of the foster care system
- ✓ Pregnant or Parenting
- ✓ Individual with a disability
- ✓ Low income individual who needs additional assistance to enter or complete an educational program or to secure/hold employment
