WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

St. Louis County residents 16-24 years of age who are currently not attending any school

Must meet one or more of the following:

- School Dropout
- Should be in school but did not attend the last calendar quarter (Compulsory Attendance)
- Low income, high school graduate who is basic skills deficient or an English language learner
- Subject to the juvenile or adult justice system
- Homeless, runaway, foster child or aged out of the foster care system
- Pregnant or Parenting
- Individual with a disability
- Low income individual who needs additional assistance to enter or complete an educational program or to secure/hold employment
