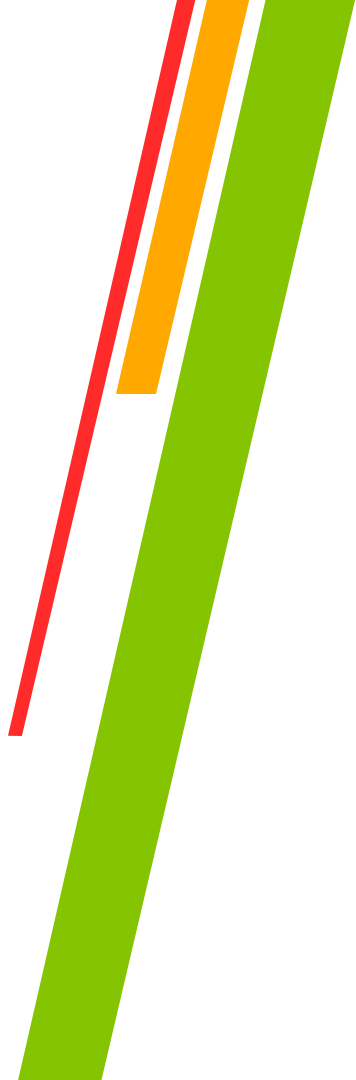

# Environmental Remediation Technician Training

---

- Prepares students to apply for state licensing in both Missouri and Illinois as lead and asbestos abatement workers
- Prepares students for jobs in hazardous waste operations (40 hours HAZWOPER)
- 6 weeks, Mon-Fri 8AM-5PM classroom instruction and hands-on activities; earns 19 certifications & 4 state licenses
- Next class: March 7

# Accelerated Training Program Minimum Requirements:

- High School diploma or equivalent & 18+ years of age
- Physical Ability to Perform Construction / Demolition activities
- Valid Driver's License
- Negative Drug Screen
- Are you workforce ready? Team player? Show up on time?

This program provides certifications to begin a career pathway for many environmental remediation careers.
